FAMILY CORNER

I think I'll be getting a goat for Christmas. I don't expect to find it under the Christmas tree on December 25th, although I would accept a goat that is a small stuffed animal. The goat I'm thinking of will be delivered to a needy family in the developing world. A few years ago, I gave a favourite priest a kitchen table for his birthday, and now, I often think about where that table might be found. This year is the first year that I've actually put such a thing on my own wish list for Christmas; like everyone else, I think having a shiny package under the tree is a great delight on Christmas morning. In the Catholic Church, we often discuss right relationships as a necessary element in our lives to make us holy. We need to have a right relationship with the Lord, but if we do not have right relationships with our neighbours, either locally or globally, it is hard to achieve the objective of a right relationship with the Lord. One of the most famous passages in Scripture is the parable of Jesus and the rich young man, a man who was saddened by Jesus' instruction to him to share his wealth. On a personal note, for some years now my family has supported a child in India through Chalice, a Catholic charitable organization that provides for the basic needs of children.
