Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

FAMILY CORNER

The university winter term started roughly, and eight hectic days after its start, the time to reflect has arrived. What made the beginning so frantic were algorithms. Algorithms are sets of rules to be used in problem-solving operations. The problem-solving operations were to schedule meeting times and to determine class sizes, and things did not go well. After careful thought and a little human ingenuity, things have settled into a normal pace, allowing me to return to reading.

I read an article in the Catholic Register on concerns raised about welfare reforms in Ontario. In this article, Dr. Gary Bloch, a poverty and welfare expert, said that relying on computers and algorithms to make decisions on who should or should not receive benefits is worrisome. After reading this article, my problems seem insignificant though similar in nature. What really struck me was that dependence on the problem-solving operations of computers eliminates interpersonal communication. I teach this subject and in my lectures, I refer to the concept of “the face of the other” proposed by Levinas, a philosopher.

In his description of “the face of the other,” Levinas suggests that the human face alone is a living presence that calls for a response; thus, we are called by others to interact. This human relation occurs even before the words of one’s language are spoken. It is this thought that made me wonder whether the whole purpose of using computer algorithms to make decisions about benefits is to spare us from hearing the call of the other’s face. Certainly, human beings have decision making rules that we follow at times but we are so much more than just rules – we are spirit. By using computer algorithms, are we trying to suppress the spirit that presents the truth through the face of the other?

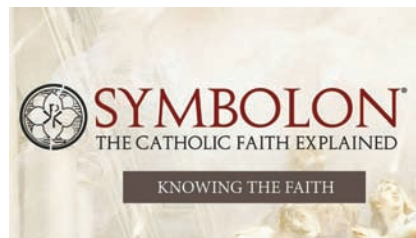
