

Fourth Sunday of Lent

Recently, Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI wrote a short letter saying that he is "on a pilgrimage towards Home." This seems like a good time to revisit what this amazing theologian had to say about Lent during the Year of Faith, October 2012 – November 2013.

During this period that commemorated Vatican II, Pope Benedict suggested that Lent offered us "a valuable opportunity to meditate on the relationship between faith and charity: between believing in God...and love, which is the fruit of the Holy Spirit and which guides us on the path of devotion..." Having faith is our response to the love of God and the "entire Christian life is a response to God's love." Faith is our acceptance of God's love, but it is not enough simply to accept his love because he wants to draw us to himself; thus, faith and charity are inseparable. "Faith is knowing the truth and adhering to it ... charity gives us the happiness of putting it into practice," Pope Benedict said. He spoke about how the letter to the Ephesians links faith and charity; in short, St. Paul said, by grace we were saved through faith, but we were created for good works.

"Lent invites us ... to nourish our faith," Pope Benedict said, and we do this by engaging in prayer, fasting, and alms giving. This is not as simple as giving up foods we like because we must have an interior life that links our faith with our service to the poor. The poor can be those who are suffering financial hardship or those who need our prayers. Whether we are praying, fasting, or being charitable, we should link our efforts with specific purposes that take us beyond ourselves and draw us toward God.
