

PASTOR'S CORNER:

Leaving old ways behind is not easy. Today's readings remind us that breaking away from the past is essential to obtaining eternal life with Jesus Christ.

After the Pharisees and scribes accuse the woman of committing adultery, Jesus provides them with the opportunity to examine their own consciences and begin a new life centred on forgiveness. They choose to walk away, silently rejecting the invitation.

It is this woman who gains freedom from her past. With her accusers gone, she is no longer bound by their punishment. But her freedom comes from the forgiveness Jesus gives her. She is left alone with this Mon, Who gives her a new chance at life. Her only instruction is to go on her way and not sin again.

Never sinning again is impossible, as we often repeat past mistakes. However the Lord's mercy is infinite and if we continue to seek forgiveness for our sins, He grants it. In this way we can work on our transgressions, leaving them behind and entering into a Christ-centred life. This work is hard, but by keeping our hearts open, we can receive Jesus' forgiveness as well as strength to begin anew.
