#### **PASTOR'S CORNER:**

A dark morning - It seems like the world is ending. Nothing remains...no future, only sadness...even the tomb is empty. No comfort to be found in grieving. If only time could turn back.

Mary Magdalene stands weeping outside the darkened tomb. She is bereft, hoping against hope, but now she is unable even to gaze on the lifeless body of her beloved Jesus who had been the promise of so much.

Unless we have suffered the loss of someone close, it is impossible to understand death. But this is even worse—a disappearance, obliteration.

Then suddenly, Jesus appears and the darkness engulfing her soul is lifted. We can imagine it is as if light bursts forth from the tomb.

This Easter, the Resurrection. A new world was born that morning when Jesus stepped out of the tomb where He had laid for three days. The sin which brought darkness was obliterated and the world began anew, bathed in the light of the Resurrection.
