

Fourth Sunday Of Easter

Some years ago a priest gave us a book, God Alone Suffices, that I have reflected upon and written about in Family Corner. In my family, the time has come for us to let go of a favourite possession, the family cottage, that has brought us many pleasant memories. Our children, and their father before them, learned to swim, paddle, and hike among the beautiful northern woods of Ontario.

The book author's point was that human beings suffer from too many attachments – to people and to things. If one can reduce dependency on other people and material things, one will have more time and energy to focus on God. We were discussing this book recently while we were planning for the sale of our cottage. The message of God Alone Suffices is indeed worth considering but, still, it is not easy to leave something behind, holding on to memories alone. Much to my surprise, the Gospel story that sprang to mind was that of the Transfiguration.

In this passage, Peter, James, and John saw the full glory of Jesus as He appeared to them with Moses and Elijah in the Transfiguration. And, what was it that Peter said to Jesus after witnessing such a glorious event? He said that he would build three dwellings to mark the site, one each for Jesus, Moses, and Elijah. There is certainly a lesson here for my family and for many others about our need to possess natural beauty by marking it with a cottage!

Both the supernatural and the natural call to us and our response is similar. We ask for signs and wonders to mark our encounters because we need material evidence of our spiritual experiences. Just like selling a family cottage, clearing away attachments is difficult but the reward is great.
