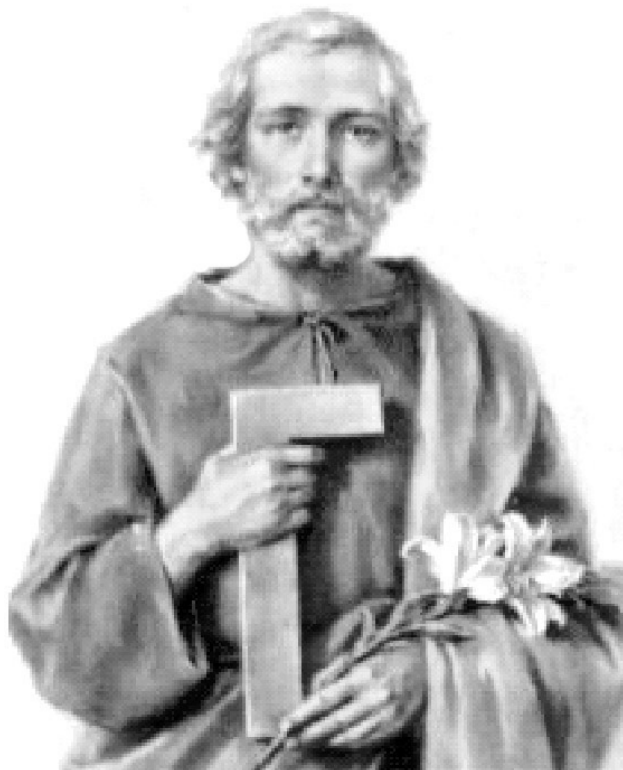

- Additional changes will be noted throughout the Mass and during announcements after Mass.

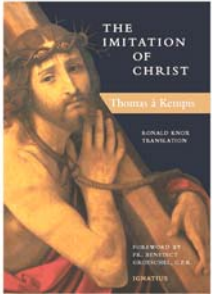

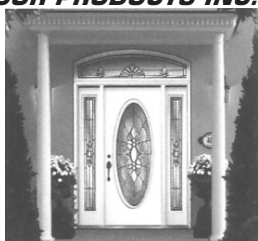
