#### RESTRICTIONS DURING LOCKDOWN BEGINNING ON DECEMBER 26

- Parishes must restrict attendance inside the church to 10 people, including priests hearing confessions or a staff member/volunteer required to monitor capacity restrictions. Due to these measures, public Masses must be temporarily cancelled.

- Holy Communion will only be given in situations of urgent necessity or danger of death. We are not permitted to distribute Holy Communion outside the context of the Mass or a Holy Communion Service.
- **Confession** will be available on a limited basis by appointment only.
