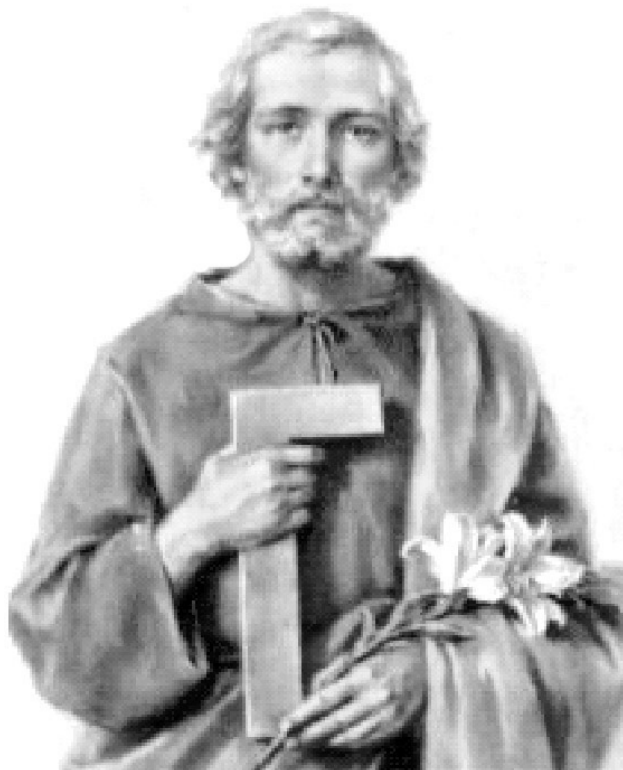

## RESTRICTIONS DURING LOCKDOWN

- **Parishes must restrict attendance inside the church to 10 people, including** priests hearing confessions or a staff member/volunteer required to monitor capacity restrictions. Due to these measures, **public Masses must be temporarily cancelled.**

- **Holy Communion will only be given in situations of urgent necessity or danger of death.** We are not permitted to distribute Holy Communion outside the context of the Mass or a Holy Communion Service.
- **Confession** will be available on a limited basis by appointment only.

## **COVID-19 UPDATE: SAFETY MEASURES FOR PRIVATE PRAYER IN THE ADORATION CHAPEL**

In light of the current pandemic, we invite you to please observe the following measures, which have been put in place for your safety and the safety of others:

To gain access to the church after 7pm and on weekends, please use the door on the left hand side with the keypad and enter the code 135. Please note that the foyer, adoration chapel and crying room are under 24 hour video surveillance. **A MAXIMUM OF 6 PEOPLE WILL**

**BE ALLOWED IN THE ADORATION CHAPEL AND 4 IN THE CRYING ROOM.** If there is no one in the chapel when you leave, please turn off the light and close the curtain. 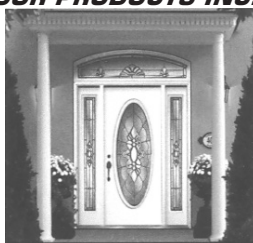
