

The Adoration Chapel is now open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The main church will remain closed. To gain access to the church after 7pm and on weekends, please use the door on the left hand

side with the keypad and enter the code 135. Please note that the foyer, adoration chapel and crying room are under 24 hour video surveillance. A MAXIMUM OF 6 PEOPLE WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE ADORATION CHAPEL AND 4 IN THE CRYING ROOM. A MASK MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES AND WE ASK THAT YOU SANITIZE YOUR AREA BEFORE LEAVING THE CHAPEL. If there is no one in the chapel when you leave, please turn off the light and close the curtain.
