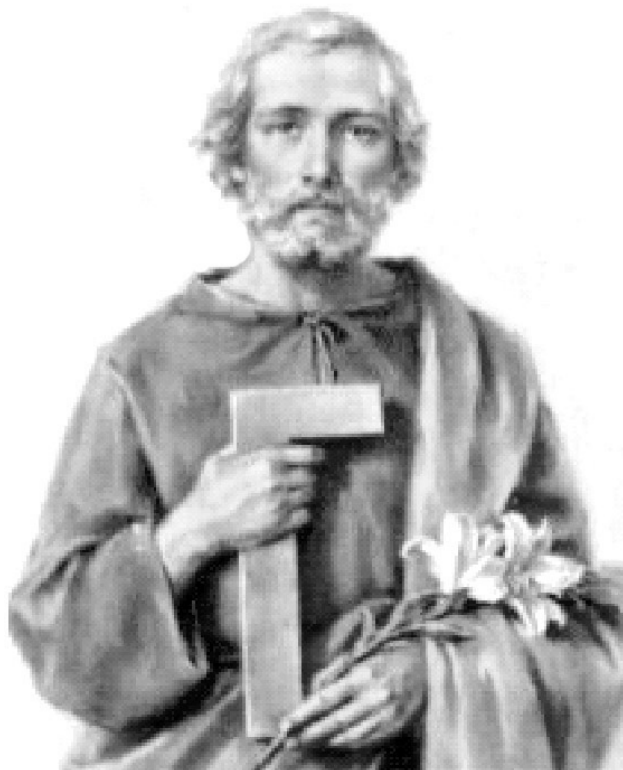

RESTRICTIONS DURING LOCKDOWN

- **Parishes must restrict attendance inside the church to 10 people, including priests hearing confessions or a staff member/volunteer required to monitor capacity restrictions.** Due to these measures, **public Masses must be temporarily cancelled.**
- **Parishioners are encouraged to view online/livestream/televised Masses.** A full list is available at www.archtoronto.org and I will continue to celebrate the livestreamed Mass each day from St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica at 7:30 a.m.
- **The Parish Office will be closed during the lockdown but staff will be working remotely** so you may call the parish office at 905-432-2300 or send an email to stjwparish@outlook.com if you need assistance.
- **Holy Communion will only be given in situations of urgent necessity or danger of death.** We are not permitted to distribute Holy Communion outside the context of the Mass or a Holy Communion Service.
- **Confession** will be available on a limited basis by appointment only.

OPEN 24 HOURS

The Adoration Chapel is now open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The main church will remain closed. To gain access to the church after 7pm and on weekends, please use the door on the left hand side with the keypad and enter the code 135. Please note that the foyer, adoration chapel and crying room are under 24 hour video surveillance. **A MAXIMUM OF 6 PEOPLE WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE ADORATION CHAPEL AND 4 IN THE CRYING ROOM. A MASK MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES AND WE ASK THAT YOU SANITIZE YOUR AREA BEFORE LEAVING THE CHAPEL.** If there is no one in the chapel when you leave, please turn off the light and close the curtain.
