

Registration for Mass

Due to the new restrictions on Mass attendance, our parish is offering tickets to reserve your spot for weekend Mass starting April 17-15. A new Eventbrite event post will be uploaded on a weekly basis every Tuesday for each upcoming weekend Mass.

Since we are currently not allowed to use our parish hall for overflow purposes, our capacity is restricted to 90 people per Mass. Online reservations to attend weekend Mass are limited to 75 tickets overall to leave room for 15 people to attend as walk-ins.

- All weekday Masses at 9 am are resumed

• Funerals are limited to 50 people (including those assisting but not including funeral home staff)


COVID-19 UPDATE: SAFETY MEASURES FOR PRIVATE PRAYER IN THE ADDRATION CHAPEL


