Registration for Mass

Due to the new restrictions on Mass attendance, our parish is offering tickets to reserve your spot for weekend Mass starting April 17-15. A new Eventbrite event post will be uploaded on a weekly basis every Tuesday for each upcoming weekend Mass.

Since we are currently not allowed to use our parish hall for overflow purposes, our capacity is restricted to 90 people per Mass. Online reservations to attend weekend Mass are limited to 75 tickets overall to leave room for 15 people to attend as walk-ins.

Weekday Mass does not require any advance registration, although the capacity limit remains 90 people

CHURCH IS NOW OPEN FOR PRIVATE PRAYER

- **All weekday Masses** at 9 am are resumed
- Our regular weekend schedule has resumed including **Saturday Mass** at 5 pm; and **Sunday Masses** at 9 am, 11 am, 1 pm and 3 pm.
- **Saturday confessions have resumed** at 4 pm. Confessions will be held in the waiting area just outside the parish office where a confessional screen will be provided to maintain anonymity. Someone will clean this space after each penitent leaves.

PRIVATE PRAYER

- The main church will be open for private prayer from 8 am to 4 pm on Sundays, Mondays through Fridays from 7:30 am to 5 pm, and Saturdays from 8 am to 10 am, followed by 3:30 pm to 6:00 pm.

WEDDINGS & BAPTISMS

- Weddings & baptisms are also permitted at 15% capacity. Baptisms are restricted to one family at a time, although the family can invite guests up to 15% capacity of the church following the 5pm Mass

FUNERALS

- Funerals are limited to 50 people (including those assisting but not including funeral home staff)

COVID-19 UPDATE: SAFETY MEASURES

FOR PRIVATE PRAYER IN THE ADORATION CHAPEL

In light of the current pandemic, we invite you to please observe the following measures, which have been put in place for your safety and the safety of others:

- **A mask or face covering is mandatory while you are in the church building.**
- Please maintain social distancing of at least six feet, unless you are from the same household
- The Adoration Chapel and crying room will be open on a 24/7
- A maximum of 6 people are allowed in the Chapel and 4 people in the Crying Room at any one time
- Please sanitize the area you were in before you leave
- A security code is required to enter the chapel during the weekend and outside of office
- The foyer, Adoration Chapel and Crying Room are under 24 hour video surveillance
