

 Are postponed at this time, although our online courses will still continue to allow our students to receive the necessary preparation to receive these important sacraments.


CONFESSION

COVID-19 UPDATE: SAFETY MEASURES FOR PRIVATE PRAYER IN THE ADORATION CHAPEL




