- Are postponed at this time, although our online courses will still continue to allow our students to receive the necessary preparation to receive these important sacraments.

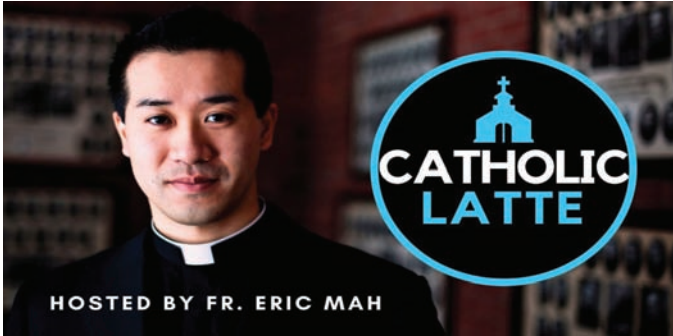
CONFESSION
