MASS IS BACK

- Effective on Fri. June 11th, parishes will be allowed to open at 15% capacity. This does not include the parish hall, such that our capacity restrictions are limited currently to 90 people per Mass.
- There is no need to reserve your spot ahead of time. Seats will be made available on a first come, first serve basis.
- Given the limited seating space available, we will retain our expanded Mass schedule for the time being, which includes the **5 pm** Mass on Saturday; and **9 am, 11 am, 1 pm** and **3 pm** Masses on Sunday.

CONFESSION

- Our regular Saturday confessions at 4 pm will resume in the waiting area outside the parish office. There will be a screen to maintain anonymity, and a volunteer will clean the confessional space between each penitent. - Weddings and baptisms are limited up to 15% capacity of the church (90 people).

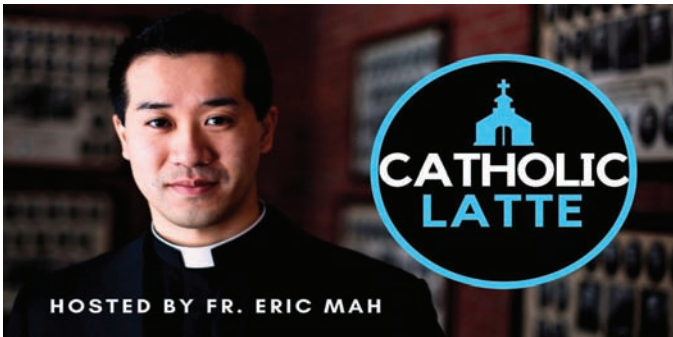
FUNERALS

COVID-19 UPDATE: SAFETY MEASURES FOR PRIVATE PRAYER IN THE ADORATION CHAPEL
