

Third Sunday of Advent



He will rejoice over you with gladness. (Zephaniah 3:17)

The third Sunday of Advent is also called Gaudete Sunday. *Gaudete* is Latin for "rejoice." Today, we light the rose-colored candle on the Advent wreath, the priest wears rose vestments, and the whole Church invites us to celebrate.

Of course, we should celebrate; we're more than halfway to Christmas! But in today's first reading, the prophet Zephaniah tells us that God is rejoicing as well. Let's consider how:

The Lord rejoices because the time of waiting is over. Just as God's people longed for the Messiah, think about how much Jesus longed for the time to come for him to be born (Galatians 4:4)! How happy he must be that his desire to forge an unbreakable covenant with us was fulfilled when he came to earth and redeemed humanity.

The Lord rejoices when we invite him to come into our lives. He exults when we accept the salvation he has won for us. Each person who turns to him makes the Lord's heart sing with gladness.

The Lord rejoices each time he renews us in his love. He delights to take each wound and heal it, to take each sin and forgive it, to take each hurt and soothe it. Every time we come to him with our needs or open our hearts to his healing, he rejoices. *The Lord rejoices* because he can share his heavenly life with us. Imagine his immense gladness in welcoming his brothers and sisters into his presence when their earthly journey is finished. Each human life is precious to him, and he celebrates the prospect of sharing the goodness of eternal life with each of us.

The Lord rejoices at being in our midst. He has not only become man and walked the earth *among* us, but he dwells in us through his Holy Spirit. This is personal—he exults to be near you today, to be part of your life. And you can rejoice because he rejoices. *"Jesus, I rejoice with you as we approach the celebration of your birth!"*
