

Twenty Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

"How long, O Lord?" (Habakkuk 1:2). That's a question we have probably all asked God at one time or another. The prophet Habakkuk was waiting for God to rescue Israel from violence and destruction. You might be waiting for a reconciliation with a loved one, for healing from a chronic disease, or for a child to return to his faith. And the longer you wait, the more tempted you might be to get frustrated and lose hope.

But waiting doesn't have to be a passive, dreaded time. As difficult as it can sometimes be, you can use this time to actively exercise your faith and let it grow.

For example, you can try to shift your focus from waiting for something to happen in the future to opening your eyes to what God is doing in the present moment. How is he loving you, encouraging you, and blessing you or the people you are praying for? The more you recognize the ways God is acting, the more you will realize that he has not abandoned you; he is with you even in your waiting. Another way to exercise your faith as you wait is to fight the temptation to doubt or despair. You might not know what God is doing or when he will do it. But you can place your trust and hope in the promise that he is always at work, even behind the scenes, to do something far greater than you could ever imagine. When God told the prophet Habakkuk that his vision had not reached fulfillment, Habakkuk probably thought he was referring to Israel's liberation from its enemies (2:3). He never imagined that God's vision was humanity's liberation from sin and death!

So even if you've been waiting for a long time, don't lose hope. God's vision for your life is pressing on to its fulfillment. And just as he told Habakkuk, so he tells you: this vision "will not disappoint; ... it will surely come" (2:3).

"Lord, even as I wait, I place my trust in you."
